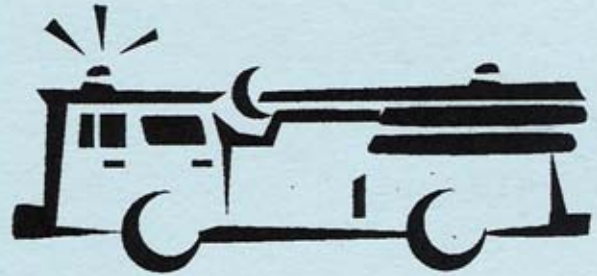

"Some businesses get started from a nighttime dream, or an idea scribbled on a cocktail napkin. Chow Fun was launched because of flame-grilled chicken.

It began when owners Everett and Shar Wong had a booth at the Redondo Beach Farmers' Market that featured their special chicken, which drew crowds because of its mystery pineapple and honey sauce. The booth led to a popular catering company. The couple's next step was their own eatery, which opened in 2004.

Their menu has familiar Chinese favorites, but the Wongs' approach harkens back to their farmers' market days - fresh ingredients and orders that are cooked on the spot, never in advance.

Appetizers include crispy crabmeat wontons, which melt with a warm mixture of cream cheese and crab, and the jade celery, petite, crunchy cuts of the vegetables that are lightly infused with a garlic sauce.

The entrees are characterized by lean meats, fresh shrimp and squid and vegetarian tofu in non-oily, homemade sauces. The tangy trademark, the honey pineapple chicken, can be found on the menu, but there are dozens of other options as well. Your favorite Kung Pao, sweet and sour, garlic, orange, and black bean dishes are here, as are adventurous new creations like tea-smoked chicken, beef with bitter melon, and pork ribs with spicy salt. There are also plenty of soups, from the "Long Life Noodle" to the hot pot combination, which melds bok choy lettuces, mushrooms and delicate meats in a steamy broth."

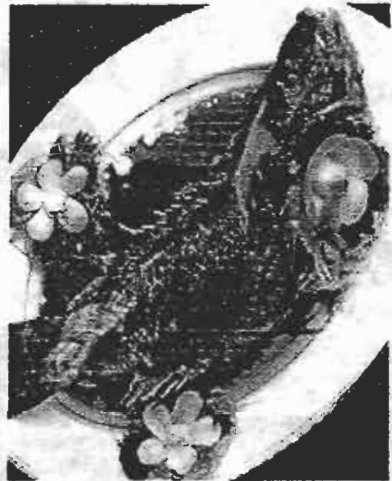

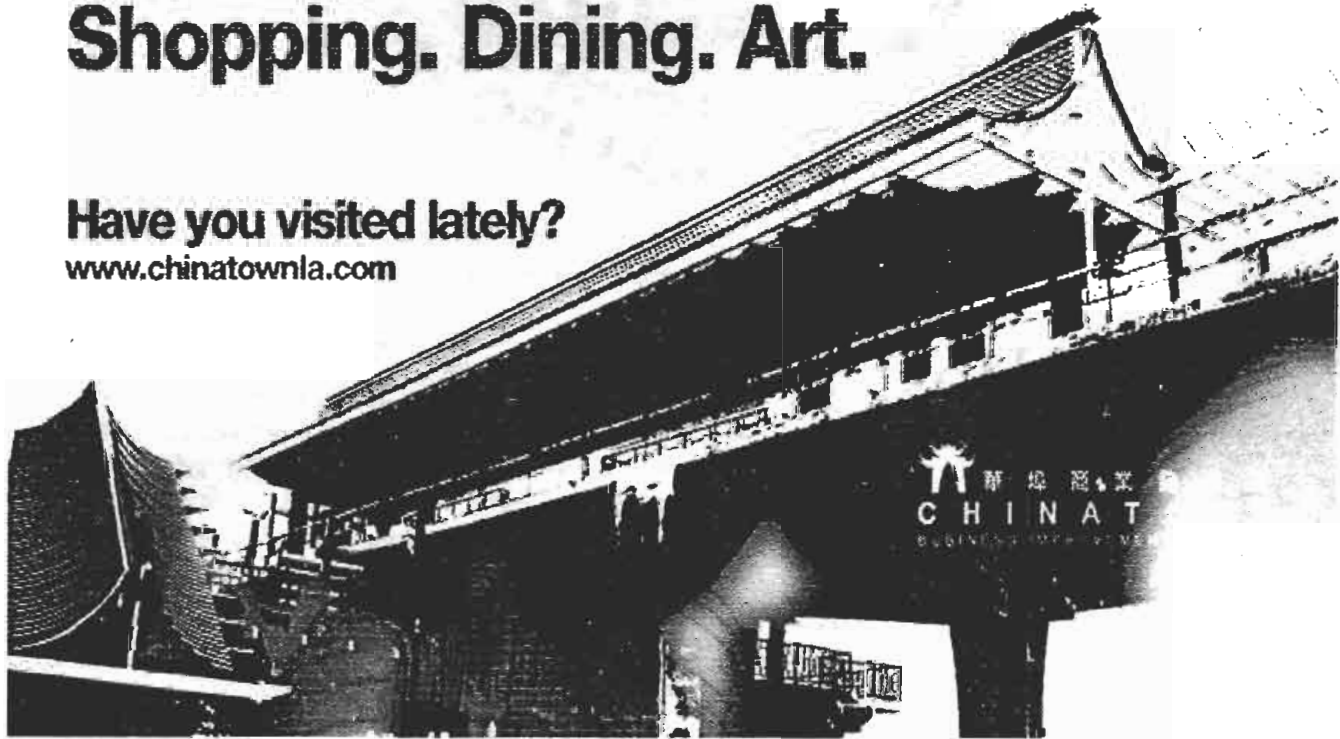
